- ◆ Provision of safe plant and systems of work; safe use, handling, transport and storage of substances; safe place of work (including access and egress) and a safe working environment with adequate welfare facilities.
- ◆ Provision of all necessary OH&S information, instruction, training and supervision to maintain safe and healthy working conditions.
- ◆ Carrying out and reviewing risk assessments on a regular basis and implementing risk control systems.
- ◆ Making adequate arrangements to encourage employees to consult with their employers on matters of Health and Safety.
- ◆ Extending our duty of care and responsibility to our customers, contractors, visitors, members of the public and anyone else working under the control of the company.

Ultimate responsibility for Health and Safety lies with the Board of Directors and through them the Executive Committee. Specific arrangements and organisational responsibilities are detailed in the Management System. The Executive Committee will review its OH&S Policy on a regular basis to ensure that the working environment continues to be a safe place for all concerned.
