

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMISSION**  
**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 (AS AMENDED)**

**THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT  
ASSESSMENT) (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 1999**

**I GIVE NOTICE** under Regulation 19(3) of the Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales) Regulations 1999 that 'Other Information' is available in relation to an Environmental Statement received by **Worcestershire County Council, County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, WR5 2NP** on 4th May 2010 submitted in support of the planning application made by Mercia Waste Management for the:

**Proposed development of an Energy from Waste Facility and associated infrastructure at Plot H600, Oak Drive, Hartlebury Trading Estate, Hartlebury Worcestershire DY10 4JB**

The planning application was called-in by the Secretary of State for his own determination on 10th May 2011 and will be the subject of a Public Inquiry (Reference: APP/E1855/V/11/2153273). As such, the 'Other Information' has been submitted specifically for the purposes of the Inquiry which will be held under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. In this case 'Other Information' means any other substantive information relating to the Environmental Statement which has been provided by the applicant

The Public Inquiry is due to commence on Tuesday 22nd November 2011 at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester WR5 2NP and is currently scheduled to sit for eight consecutive working days, excluding Monday 28th November.
